## ABOUT THE WILD BURSARY

---

The Chris Wild (ON 1991) Indigenous Bursary was established in 2012. Chris Wild, the son of Rob (ON 1964) and Jenny Wild, was a teacher by profession with a passion for Indigenous education. Following his tragic death in 2011, the Wild Family, their friends and a number of generous Newington Old Boys established the Bursary in his memory.

The Wild Bursary is the most significant of the named Bursaries in our Endowment Fund.

*When fully funded, the Chris Wild (ON 1991) Indigenous Bursary will annually award a fee free, six-year Newington education to a worthy and deserving Indigenous boy.*

## WILD AMBASSADORS

---

The Wild Bursary has a goal to raise \$5 million. In the meantime, a group of Old Boys have gathered as Ambassadors for the College's Indigenous Program and are generously personally funding all current bursaries in the name of Chris Wild. In this way, the Wild Bursary is already achieving whilst the Fund corpus is allowed to build.

The first of these six year bursaries was awarded in 2014, the second in 2016, the third beginning in 2019 and the fourth to start in 2020.

Newington College sincerely thanks these generous Old Boys for their ongoing support of the vision of the Wild Family and to successfully establish our Indigenous Program in this way.

## WILD PROGRESS

---

The Wild Indigenous Bursary program continues to go from strength to strength.

In 2017 a number of generous Old Boys and Parents offered to underwrite the annual fundraising appeal held during June. Together with the College's ongoing support of this program, a donor matching program was established with all donations matched 2 for 1 up to \$225,000. The appeal was a fantastic success, with the Newington Community raising an amazing \$243,000 during June for the Wild Bursary.

Total fundraising for 2017 for the Wild Indigenous Bursary was \$334,000, with the Fund corpus now at \$1.2 million.

But there is no time for congratulations as the goal is \$5 million and reaching this figure means we can fund the opportunity for an Indigenous boy to be offered a six-year Bursary every year, forever.

*Supporting the Newington Indigenous program will benefit the whole community with our young men ready to inspire future generations by their knowledge and leadership.*

## 2018 DONOR MATCHING PROGRAM

---

### **Our 2018 goal is to raise \$1.2 million by 30 June. Why \$1.2 million?**

With the ongoing support of the College, generous Old Boys and benefactors, we are excited to be able to offer 2 for 1 matching for up to \$400,000 of fundraising. If we raise \$400,000, matching funding of \$800,000 will be gifted, giving us \$1.2 million.

\$1.2 million also sees us all but halfway to our goal of \$5 million and with the goodwill and support of current and new Ambassadors, this will mean we will be awarding a Wild Bursary every year from 2020.

### **Will you help us reach our \$1.2 million goal by 30 June 2018?**

Your fully tax-deductible donation is worth three times as much to us - \$500 is worth \$1,500; \$1,000 becomes \$3,000 and \$5,000 would become \$15,000. With your support, we can reach this goal.
