





'know the boys within their Mentor Group better than any other adult in the school'





Compulsory Events must take priority.




#### **Absences**

- Information about how to notify the school regarding absences will be sent to all parents in January 2018.
- If your son is going to be absent from school you can send an SMS text before 8:30 am as your official notification of his absence and no further note is required. If we do not receive that SMS before school or if your son is not present when the rolls are marked at the start of Period 1, we will send an SMS text to your mobile phone number to let you know that we have recorded your son as "absent" on the school roll that morning. It is important for parents to respond to this SMS as we have a duty of care to know where the boys are when they should be at school.
- If absent, the expectation is that boys catch up on all missed work and check individual subject Canvas pages.


